CLIFFSIDE PARK LIBRARY OFFERING FREE CARDS IN SEPTEMBER

(CLIFFSIDE PARK) – “As part of its recognition of September being National Library Card Sign-up month, the Cliffside Park Free Public Library is encouraging residents to sign up for a library card or trade old wallet library cards for a new key chain card at no cost,” said Library Director Camille Valentino Steinfeld .

“In September, the Library is waiving the usual \$2.00 fee for a new library card,” said Ms. Steinfeld. ”This is a perfect opportunity to get a new or newer library card.”

According to Steinfeld, having a library card allows you access to almost everything on line and in print while receiving the personal assistance to help locate the information you need. Cliffside Park’s Library offers so much—books, DVDs, CDs, Internet access, on line data bases and more. Libraries are also dynamic community centers offering book discussion groups, musical performances, story hours and other programs for children as well as adults.
