ORDINANCE 2009-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III AND XXV CONCERNING MANDATORY RECYCLING OF NEWSPAPERS AND RECYCLING OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF CLIFFSIDE PARK

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Cliffside Park previously established mandatory recycling in 1990; and

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the last ordinance there have been amendments to the applicable Bergen County District Solid Waste Management Plan, which amendments require the Borough to amend its ordinance to comply with the said State and County requirements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF CLIFFSIDE PARK, COUNTY OF BERGEN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The following materials are hereby included as mandatory recyclables:

Ferrous Scrap	Ferrous Scrap
Leaves	White Goods

Grass	Construction and Demolition debris (concrete, brick, tree parts, nonferrous/ferrous metal, asphalt, corrugated cardboard, where practical)

Corrugated Cardboard	
Mixed Paper	
Type 1 and Type 2 Plastic Containers	

SECTION 2: Section 25-14(b)(1) and 26-1 is amended to include all of the mandatory recyclables as set forth in Section 1 above.

SECTION 3: Section 25-14(B)(!) is amended to include the following: Construction and Demolition Debris (concrete, brick, tree parts, nonferrous/ferrous metals, asphalt, corrugated cardboard shall be placed separately in Type I and II Plastic Containers.

SECTION 4: Section 3-10-1 is amended to confirm with the terms of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.

SECTION 6: Severability.

If any section, sentence or other part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, but shall be confined in its effect to the section, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy which such judgment shall be rendered.

SECTION 7: Repealer.

All Ordinances of the Borough of Cliffside Park which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
